Detailed behavioral profiles that give insight into what drives the basic behaviors of lost people.



Statistical Information
Find location, scenario analysis, mobility time, survivability, elevation changes, track offset dispersion angles, plus classic statistics such as distance from the initial planning point.



Probable Area
The ability to pinpoint the most likely areas to search, then determine initial tasks quickly using reflex tasking, the bike wheel model, and quick consensus.



Expert Case Studies
The course will review real life situations to determine best practices for unique situations.
