

Be Prepared

The weather is rolling in this week and panic may be setting in. Some families along the gulf coast are still recovering from Harvey. IF weather is projected to hit your area, please consider the following as you watch the news and prepare your families, friends, and neighbors.

1. Know what you are watching and who you are listening to!

Media is all about the hype! Make sure the information you are getting is accurate and relevant; we suggest monitoring the following sources to get accurate and current information.

NHC - Hurricane Center

DPS - Texas Department of Public Safety

*Pay attention to your local emergency management - their number one priority is to keep you safe - listen to them!

2. If your area is under orders to evacuate, abide by them!

If you are unable to evacuate or need assistance in doing so, contact local authorities to seek advice and resources. Be sure to register with STEAR (2-1-1) again this year if you need assistance during evacuation, by dialing 2-1-1 from your phone or visiting www.dps.texas.gov/dem/stear/public.htm.

*Allow the first responders to help handle emergencies that couldn't be prevented.

3. Start preparations around the house

- · Clean out storm drains and remove any debris from the yard that might clog it.
- Trim any dead limbs that might become projectiles in heavy winds.
- Treat fire ants on the property. These guys become satanic rafts of evil in flood waters.
- Have a week's worth of medication on hand and know where vital records are kept.
- Keep your gas tank full.
- Catch up on the laundry.
- Stock up on canned goods, pet supplies and water. Enough for a week.
- · Catch up on chores that require power and internet service.

Do what you can to prepare yourself and your family, it may blow over, but if it doesn't you will be glad you took the time to prepare. Hurricane Harvey definitely taught us Texans to not underestimate the power of a storm!

Our thoughts are with the teams deployed to the Carolinas in support of Hurricane Florence. TEXSAR is prepared for deployment across state lines but is also considering the help that could be needed here in the coming days as the team is already on Standby.
